We have to correct a fact we stated in our last letter. We have only received \$4000 not \$5000 for the Yolanda Typhoon damage repair of our first church. It needs a completely new roof. It is 300 sq meters in size and has quite a span for the roof. We have purchased the steel to make the trusses and a welding machine to weld. We praise the Lord that there are 2 of our students that can weld. Just that steel for the trusses costs over \$2000. We need cement and block to repair the damaged walls and make the roof typhoon proof as possible. We need the farlings that go across the trusses and then of course the roofing material the goes on top and paint. Please continue to pray for this project and the financial need to get it done. It is in the heart of the city and it needs a working church there. We see great potential in getting that work back up and running. The estimate just to do the roof is \$15,000.



We had our annual Jesus Birthday Party Sunday and New Years Eve time of preaching and fireworks in December. January is our stewardship and missions month and the emphasis was on "Soulwinning". But they don't understand it was the best place for them to be.

Thanks to the Lord providing a caring individual we were able to complete the repair on our one jeepney and it looks brand new. Pray that our van will hold together for a little while longer, until there are funds to fix it.

We are headed for the states for a longer furlough than we have done before. After 22 years this will be the longest one and only about the 4th time I have been in the states. We would like to touch base with some of our supporting churches and raise our support level. It has always been low. We want the ability to help more of our graduates start churches. If it's the Lord's will, we want to build up the college but it needs more finances to function.

So Pray for finances to rebuild our first church, building and people. Pray for our members that they will become great soulwinners so more can be saved from hell. Pray finances for our other vehicle whose body is not too good. Pray for our time in the states that we will be always in God's will and see all financial needs met and for safety as we travel. Pray for ability to grow our college. Especially pray for the church and our National Pastor, Arnel Gevero, while we are in the states. Pray all will be faithful soulwinners, more faithful members, more to be discipled and faithful to the commitments they have made. We do praise the Lord that He has provided a vehicle for us to drive while there. We are truly grateful for all the prayers that go up for us. You have no idea what God does because of your prayers.
